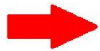

For example, look at the row to which the arrow is pointing. This row is for this year - 5784 - which is a MEM-ZAYIN-CHET year-type. MEM is for M'UBERET, ZAYIN is for this year's first day of Rosh HaShana - Shabbat. And CHET is for CHASEIR, which means that Kislev only has 29 days - it usually has 30.

Notice that the row is also for a 12-month year that begins on Shabbat and is CHASEIR. Since Chanuka is before Adar, the days of the week for Chanuka are the same whether the year has one or two Adars. Only the first day of Rosh HaShana and the status of Marcheshvan and Kislev matter for fixing the days of the week of Chanuka.

You can see that Chanuka runs from Friday to Friday - first candle is Thursday night.

This arrangement of Chanuka has a 10.1% frequency (as you see, made up of two year-types with frequencies of 4.3% and 5.8%). Friday to Friday Chanuka has Vayeishev as Chanuka and Mikeitz (the common Shabbat Chanuka sedra) is the day after Chanuka and thus has its regular haftara (the story of Shlomo and the two babies) rather than the special Shabbat Chanuka haftara - usually the first Shabbat Chanuka, sometimes the second Shabbat Chanuka (as seen on the bottom row). 14 year-types and six possible days of the week for Chanuka 1.
